

Rev **Samuel Ahmuty** 1740-1800

Vicar of Ballimahon, co. Longford. 1757 admitted Trinity College, Dublin. He m1 his cos **Susannah Maria Savage** 1742-1790, daughter of Francis Savage and Elizabeth, daughter of James Achmuty, Dean of Armagh, and m2 **Sarah King** d 1799.

Samuel of Ballimahon, co. Longford m 1806 **Margaret Christiana Lyons**, d 1852 dau of John Lyons of Ladiston, co. Meath. Children:

the only son of Samuel of Ballymahon, co. Longford and Margaret Lyons, dof John Lyons of Ladiston, co. Westmeath. In 1830 he attended Brasenose College, Oxford gaining in 1834 a B.A. and an M.A. in 1836. From 1867 until his death in 1871, Samuel was the first rector of St. Leonard, Broad Blunsdon, Wilts. He m **Louisa Caroline Freeman** 1815-1897

Inscription on stained glass window in **St. Leonard's Church, Broad Blunsdon**: 'Erected by his widow to the Glory of God and in memory of the Rev'd S. F. Auchmuty who died April 5th 1871 aged 59'

Inscription on stained glass window in **St. Andrew's Church, Broad Blunsdon**: 'In loving memory of Louisa Caroline Auchmuty born 1815 died 1897 erected by her children.'

Memorial in St Andrew's Church, Broad Blunsdon: 'Her bereaved husband wishes in putting up this plate to associate with the Church and Parish so dear to her the most beloved memory of Frances Caroline Lechmere, second daughter of the late Rev'd Samuel Forbes Auchmuty, first rector, who died at Clifton October 5th 1874 aged 28 and whose mortal part rests in the churchyard of Blunsdon St. Andrews. Till the day break and the shadows flee away.'
3. **Octavia Isabella** m **Hubert Stretton**
4. **Samuel Forbes Frederick** 1841-1917. 'On the 9th November 1864 at the Church of St John the Evangelist, Colaba, India, by the Rev Ward Maule, Samuel Forbes Frederick Auchmuty, Esq., Lieut HM's 28th Regiment m **Agnes Sophia Woodd** (1835-1916) younger daughter of the late W H T Woodd, Esq., of Maida Hill, London.' - from the Times of India. Samuel was vicar of the **Church of St. Barnabas, Horton cum Studley, Oxfordshire**. From 1897-1917 he was vicar of **St. Mary the Virgin, Cleobury Mortimer, Shropshire** where there is a stained glass window in his memory and a memorial to Agnes Sophia Auchmuty who died Dec 23rd 1916, aged 81. He was author of 'The History of Cleobury Mortimer' published 1911, reprinted 1996.

Mortimer: 'Charles George Auchmuty, 3rd son of the Vicar of this parish, died at Sacramento, USA on March 14th 1914, aged 41.

5. **Arthur Compton** 1842-1918. The 2nd son of Samuel of Blunsdon, Wilts. In 1861 he entered Lincoln College, Oxford gaining a B.A. in 1865 and an M.A. in 1869. In 1862 his prize poem 'Julian the Apostate' was recited in the Theatre, Oxford. In 1873 he was vicar of Lucton, Hereford.

Margaret Christiana Lyons d 1852

1806 m **Rev Samuel Ahmuty** of Ballimahon (Ballymuloy) co. Longford. Later she was of Hawkhurst, Kent and finally of Medsted, Southampton. Margaret was the daughter of John Lyons of Ledestown. High Sheriff 1778, who married in 1765 Caroline Degennes, 3rd dau of Lieut.-Col. John Degennes, of Portarlinton. John Lyons d 1803 and was succeeded by his grandson.
