Sir

The attention of the Charity Commissioners has been directed to the terms of the Will of the late Miss Jemima A'hmuty which was proved at the Principal Registry on the 28th January last.

It appearing therefrom that the above mentioned legacy was directed to be invested and the income only applied for charitable purposes.

I am to suggest that the above-mentioned sum of £1,000 should be paid under the authority of an order of the Board of Charity Commissioners to the account of "The Official Trustees of Charitable Funds" at the Bank of England for investment in their corporate name in trust for the Charity. The advantages of this course will be seen on reference to the accompanying memorandum.

A Form of Application for the necessary Order is enclosed which may be returned to this Office when duly filled up and signed, if the course suggested be approved. Several benefactions for the benefit of Chelsea have been transferred in the manner here proposed.
